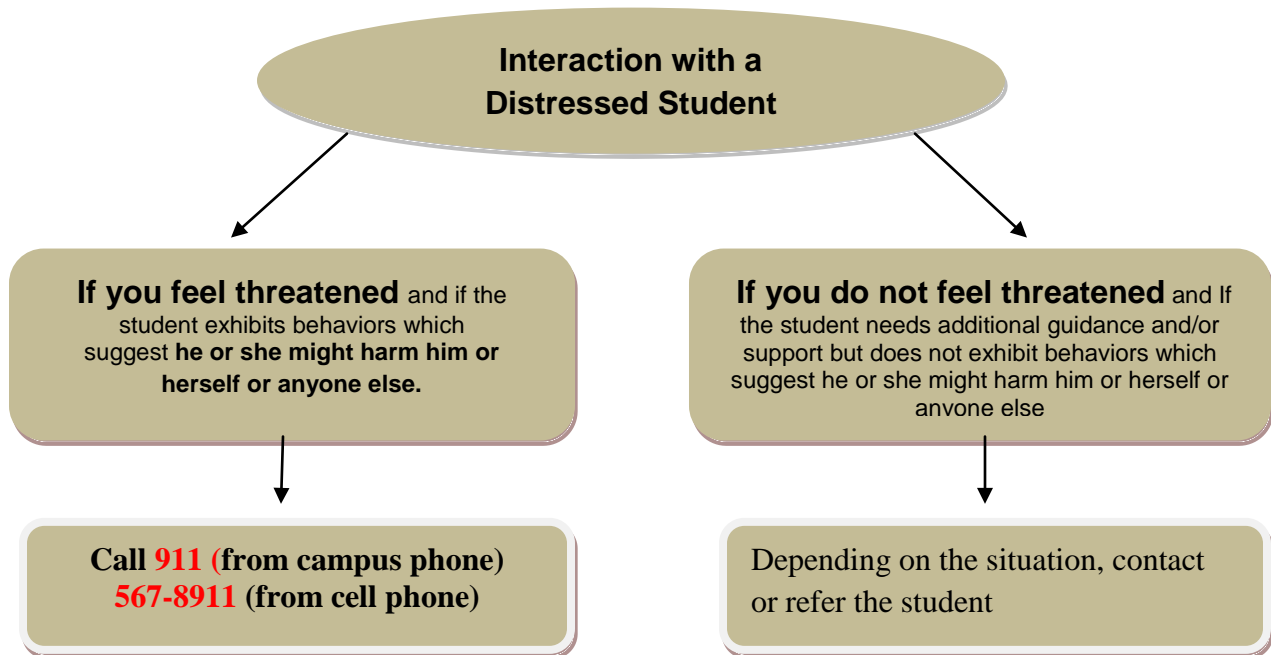


Crisis Response Quick Reference
